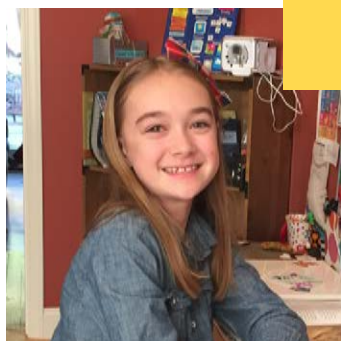

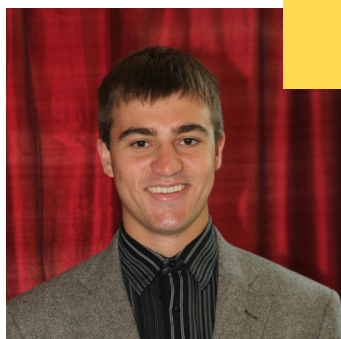
## XAVIER
