Our Programs

INDEPENDENT STUDY

GRADES: 9-12

Students receive a free Chromebook to complete their work online and meet with their teacher regularly either virtually or in a public place, like a library or coffee shop. This flexible program allows students to work, catch up on credits and earn their diploma safely from home. Starting Fall 23/24 students receive a budget of \$1,500 for activities, projects and community college materials.

UNIVERSITY PREP

GRADES: 9-12

This academy is similar to Independent Study but includes honors classes to prepare students for college or university. Students meet with their teacher one-on-one and in small groups with other students. A free Chromebook is provided so students can complete their courses online from home. Starting Fall 23/24 students receive a budget of \$1,500 for activities, projects and community college materials.

HOME SCHOOL

GRADES: TK-8

Teachers partner with parents to provide an excellent home school education. Students in grades TK-8 are provided \$3,000 (starting Fall 23/24). This instructional resources budget is used for curriculum, enrichment activities and materials so families can customize their student's education. Parent educators provide four to six hours of daily instruction and receive support from a credentialed teacher.
