Visions In Education focuses on the wellbeing of our students. Not only do we provide a personalized education but we also offer services to help students manage their mental health.

## Services

Visions is partnered with **Care Solace**, a free online coordination tool that connects students and families with mental health services in their community.



## Supportive Staff

We have a full team of **15 counselors, 5 social workers and a Foster and Homeless Liaison** to support our community. This team also organizes online classes and workshops.

## Resources

Students have access to tons of digital wellness resources on topics like coping skills, personal growth, dealing with crises and more. Visions also offers a “mobile library” that is brought to our in-person events and a “virtual calming room”.

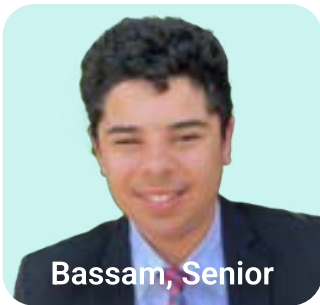
