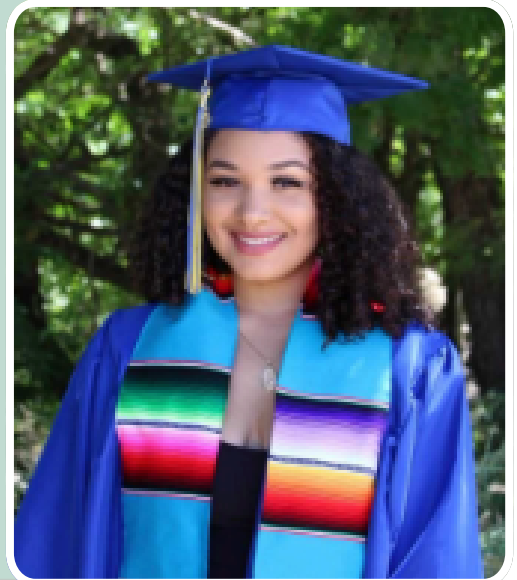

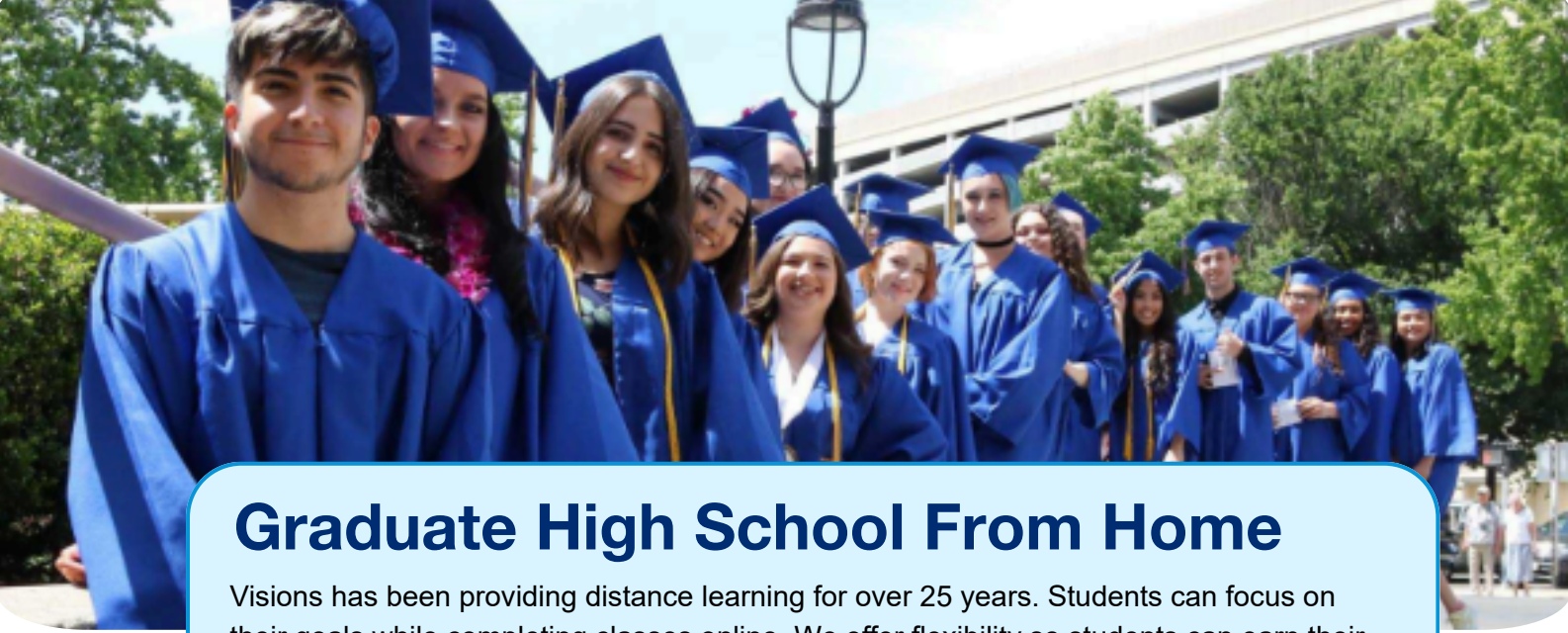

Choose from hundreds of approved vendors and use your student budget to learn coding, karate, art and more. You can also take driver's ed!

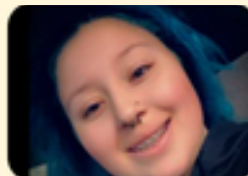
## Mentoring & Writing

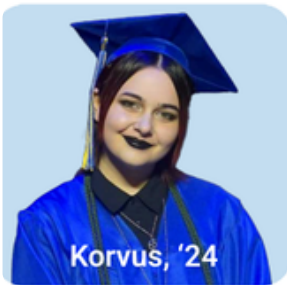
