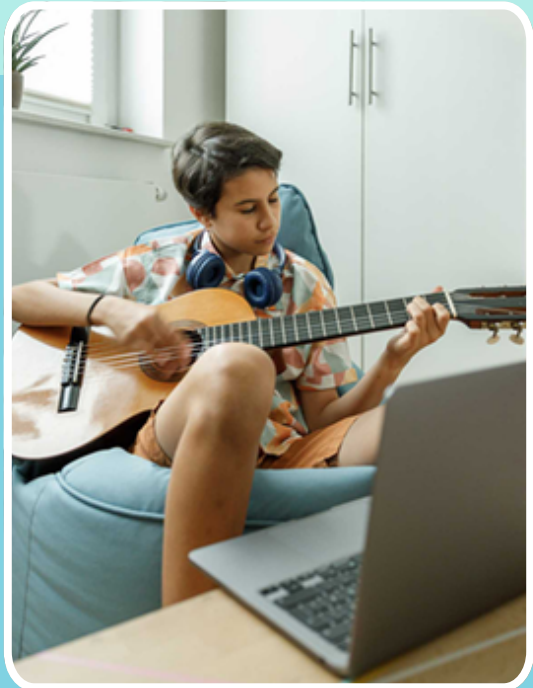

Visions is partnered with **Care Solace**, a free online coordination tool that connects students and families with mental health services in their community.

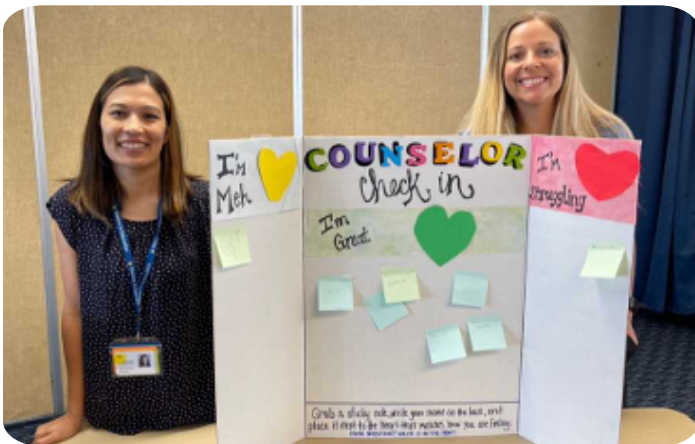


## Supportive Staff
